IN THE MATTER OF THE FILING BY ) ORDER GRANTING HUMBOLDT MUNICIPAL GAS UTILITY FOR A ) WAIVER WAIVER OF 49-C.F.R. 192.285(A)(2) AND C.F.R. ) 192.285(C) PS13-005

On June 20, 2013, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Humboldt Municipal Gas Utility requesting a waiver of 49 CFR 192.285(c) with respect to requalification of persons making plastic joints. The City of Humboldt operates Humboldt Municipal Gas Utility, which serves approximately 289 customers. On June 27, 2013, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of July 12, 2013, to interested individuals on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listsery. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed. On August 7, 2013, Pipeline Safety Staff filed a memorandum recommending conditions on the requalification waiver.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-34B, specifically, SDCL 49-34B-24. At its regularly scheduled meeting on August 13, 2013, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission voted unanimously to grant a waiver of 49 CFR 192.285(a)(2) and 49 CFR 192.285(c) subject to PHMSA approval and the following conditions:

- 1. A person must be re-qualified under the applicable joining procedure at least once each calendar year, at intervals not exceeding fifteen months.
- 2. If a joiner has one joint made under this procedure that is found to be unacceptable by testing under 49 CFR 192.513, that person must be re-qualified under the applicable joining procedure as an initial qualification.

It is therefore

ORDERED, that Humboldt Municipal Gas Utility is granted a waiver of 49 CFR 192.285(c) subject to PHMSA approval and to the above-stated conditions.
