Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota) herewith respectfully files its fuel and purchased power (F&PP) adjustment pursuant to its Rate 58.

Exhibit A is the 59<sup>th</sup> Revised Sheet No. 27.2 showing the proposed Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment to be effective with service rendered on and after May 1, 2021, pursuant to Commission approval.

Exhibit B, page 1 summarizes the fuel and purchased power adjustment calculated pursuant to the terms of Rate 58 authorized in Docket No. EL15-024. The total F&PP adjustment is 1.965 cents per Kwh that will apply during the month of May 2021. Pages 2 through 4 show the calculation of the adjustment which is based on a four month historical average cost of fuel and purchased power.

The net effect of this F&PP adjustment is a decrease from the currently effective rates of 0.601 cents per Kwh for service rendered in the month of May 2021.

All of Montana-Dakota's retail electric customers in South Dakota will be affected by this proposal. There were 8,486 customers in South Dakota as of March 31, 2021.
