Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota) herewith respectfully files its fuel and purchased power (F&PP) adjustment pursuant to its Rate 58.

Exhibit A is the 67<sup>th</sup> Revised Sheet No. 27.2 showing the proposed Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment to be effective with service rendered on and after January 1, 2022, pursuant to Commission approval.

Exhibit B, page 1 summarizes the fuel and purchased power adjustment calculated pursuant to the terms of Rate 58 authorized in Docket No. EL15-024. The total F&PP adjustment is 2.295 cents per Kwh that will apply during the month of January 2022. Pages 2 through 4 show the calculation of the adjustment which is based on a four month historical average cost of fuel and purchased power.

The net effect of this F&PP adjustment is a decrease from the currently effective rates of 0.093 cents per Kwh for service rendered in the month of January 2022.

All of Montana-Dakota's retail electric customers in South Dakota will be affected by this proposal. There were 8,469 customers in South Dakota as of November 30, 2021.
