Plaintiff, the state of South Dakota by and through the Public Utilities Commission ("Plaintiff" or "Commission") an agency of the State of South Dakota, hereby makes application to the Court for entry of judgment by default in the aboveentitled action pursuant to SDCL 15-6-55(b).

1. The Commission commenced this action on June 21, 2011 when the Minnehaha County Sheriff personally serviced the Summons and Complaint on Lori Olson the registered agent for Olson Digging, Inc. (herein "Olson Digging"). The Sheriff's return of service is attached as Exhibit A.

2. Defendant neither Answered nor filed any other pleading in reply.

3. This action was originally brought pursuant to SDCL 49-7A-28 to recover

the civil penalty assessed against Defendant by the South Dakota One-Call Notification Board ("One-Call").

4. One-Call ("One-Call") is a board established by SDCL 49-7A-2.

5. One-Call, pursuant to SDCL 49-7A-17, has the authority to receive complaints against persons who violate provisions of SDCL chapter 49-7A and rules

promulgated by One-Call and may, pursuant to SDCL 49-7A-18 and 49-7A-19, assess civil penalties against persons found to have violated these laws.

6. On September 13, 2010, pursuant to SDCL 49-7A-17, One-Call received three separate complaints filed by NorthWestern Energy. The Complaints are based on Defandant's failure to properly have utility facilities marked prior to excavation and failure to notify the facility operator after damaging utility facilities in violation of SDCL 49-7A.

7. After notice of each Complaint was given pursuant to 49-7A-23 and 24, Defendant Answered on October 27, 2010. A five member panel, appointed by the Chairman of One Call pursuant to SDCL 49-7A-22, determined probable cause existed to believe violations of SDCL 49-7A occurred.

8. A copy of the One-Call panel's recommendations was sent to the parties pursuant to SDCL 49-7A-27. Defendant, however, failed to respond to the recommendations. Its failure to respond, and failure to request a hearing, constitutes acceptance of the panel's recommendations per SDCL 49-7A-27

9. The panel's recommendations include a combined civil penalty against Defendant that now totals Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$11,000).

10. Individual Orders for OC10-006, 007 and 008 were served on Defendant via first class mail. The Defendant neither appealed the One-Call decision nor paid the civil penalty, and accordingly, owes Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$11,000) in civil penalties.

11. One-Call made a written demand to Defendant for payment of the civil penalties as required by SDCL 49-7A-33. The demand was served by first class mail on Defendant April 6, 2011. A copy of the written demand is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

12. At the request of One-Call, the Commission brought an action in this court against Defendant to recover such penalty in accordance with SDCL 49-7A-28.

13. Defendant has neither paid anything to the Commission nor One-Call in satisfaction of the Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$11,000) in civil fines levied by One-Call nor given any indication to the Commission or One-Call that he intends to pay the fines.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests that the Court enter judgment by default against Defendant as follows:

1. For a monetary judgment in the amount of \$11,000 against Defendant.

Dear Ms. Olson;

On September 13, 2010 NorthWestern Energy filed three complaints against your company. Scott Olson answered the complaints in writing on October 11, 2010. The Enforcement Panel of the South Dakota One Call Notification Board met regarding all three complaints and found probable cause to believe Scott Olson Digging violated South Dakota codified law. The Panel accessed penalties in the following amounts:

- i) In case number OC10-006 a \$1,000 penalty.
- ii) In case number OC10-007 a \$5,000 penalty.
- iii) In case number OC10-008 a \$5,000 penalty.

Your company had thirty days to object to the Panel's findings. Your failure to do so results in acceptance of said penalties. Your company now owes \$11,000 in civil penalties. Larry Janes, the One Call executive director sent the enclosed letter on March 24, 2011 giving you additional time to address your violations. You have, to date, failed to make any attempt to pay the penalties or make other arrangements.

You are hereby demanded, pursuant to SDCL 49-7A-33 to pay said penalty within thirty days of receipt of this letter. If you do not pay the penalty, the Public Utilities Commission may bring an action in the name of the State of South Dakota against your company in circuit court. See SDCL 49-7A-28. Please contact me with any questions.

Mr. Olson:

This is a reminder notice of the six thousand dollars (\$6,000) which was due to South Dakota One Call on March 16, 2011. This is in regards to the South Dakota One Call Board Orders Adopting Enforcement Panel Recommendations on Complaints OC10-006, OC10-007, and OC10-008, which were mailed to you on February 18, 2011 and delivered by Priority Mail on February 22, 2011.

OC10-006 - Damaging service pipe and failure to notify Northwestern Energy of that damage at Lincoln Avenue NW (nearest intersection Third Street SW) in Huron, SD on July 27, 2010. This Order requires a penalty payment of one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

OC10-007 - Damaging a 90 degree elbow and pipe where the service entered a customer's property at Lincoln Avenue NW (nearest intersection Third Street SW) in Huron, SD on July 27, 2010. This Order requires a penalty payment of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500). An additional amount of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500). OC10-008 - Completing work prior to the start date on a locate ticket at Lawnridge Avenue SE, from Third Street SE to Seventh Street SE in Huron, SD on August 27, 2010. This Order requires a penalty payment of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500). An additional amount of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) was suspended, if payment was received by March 16, 2010.

Because payment was not received by March 16, 2011 and because no effort has been made by Scott Olson Digging, Inc. to contact South Dakota One Call to arrange to make payments, the suspended amounts totaling the additional five thousand dollars (\$5,000) are now also due. If you contact South Dakota One Call in writing by Friday, April 1, 2011 to make arrangements for either a one-time payment of six thousand dollars (\$6,000) or some other reasonable monthly payment amount agreed to by South Dakota One Call, we may agree not to impose the additional suspended amounts of five thousand dollars (\$5,000). If no response is received from Scott Olson Digging, Inc. by the close of business on April 1, 2011, then the total amount of eleven thousand dollars (\$11,000) will be imposed and the collection process will begin. Please contact us to make payment arrangements no later than April 1, 2011 at:

I sincerely hope that you understand that our goal is compliance with South Dakota One Call laws for the safety of you, your workers, and the general public. We have no interest in receiving complaints and issuing penalties.
