COMES now Northern States Power Company d/b/a Xcel Energy and moves the Commission to extend the current deadline for final approval of the project in this docket to July 1, 2007.

This motion is based upon the following considerations:

'1. By its order dated September 11, 2006, the Commission granted Xcel Energy's request to waive the one-year deadline set forth in SDCL § 49-41B-24 and provided an additional period of time until December 31, 2006, for the Commission's final decision to be rendered in this matter. The Commission's decision was predicated in part upon Xcel Energy's representation that it had encountered unanticipated problems with route approvals.

2. Xcel Energy continues to work with the Federal Highway Administration, the Minnesota Department of Transportation and the South Dakota Department of Transportation concerning route approvals. While progress has been made, the necessity of litigation in Minnesota to bring this matter to a conclusion has lengthened the time for resolution of all route issues beyond that originally anticipated by Xcel Energy.

3. Xcel Energy and Commission Staff believe that all route approvals can eventually be obtained. It would create unnecessary delay and additional expense to require Xcel Energy to refile this proceeding and commence the process anew. For this reason, Xcel respectfully requests that the Commission grant the motion.

WHEREFORE Xcel Energy prays that the Commission grant its motion to extend the deadline for the Commission's final decision to July 1, 2007.
