Question:

Referring to Xcel's response to data request 1-7, when does Xcel plan to review the non-compliance charges? Will this be completed before summer of 2016, when MISO is expected to start calling on controllable load more frequently?

Response:

The Company does not yet have a defined schedule for reviewing non-compliance charges. We plan to closely monitor MISO developments and program experience, including the outcome of the waiver petition and our ability to work with customers to modify their participation in the tariffs for Peak and Energy Controlled Services. This information will inform next steps and potential adjustments to our demand response portfolio. Next steps may involve two types of adjustment: (1) changes to existing programs to better align with MISO rules and requirements and (2) development of new programs or rates to attract additional customer participation.

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
