*I would like to request Northwestern Corporation to provide electric service to the above listed location for my new hog service.*

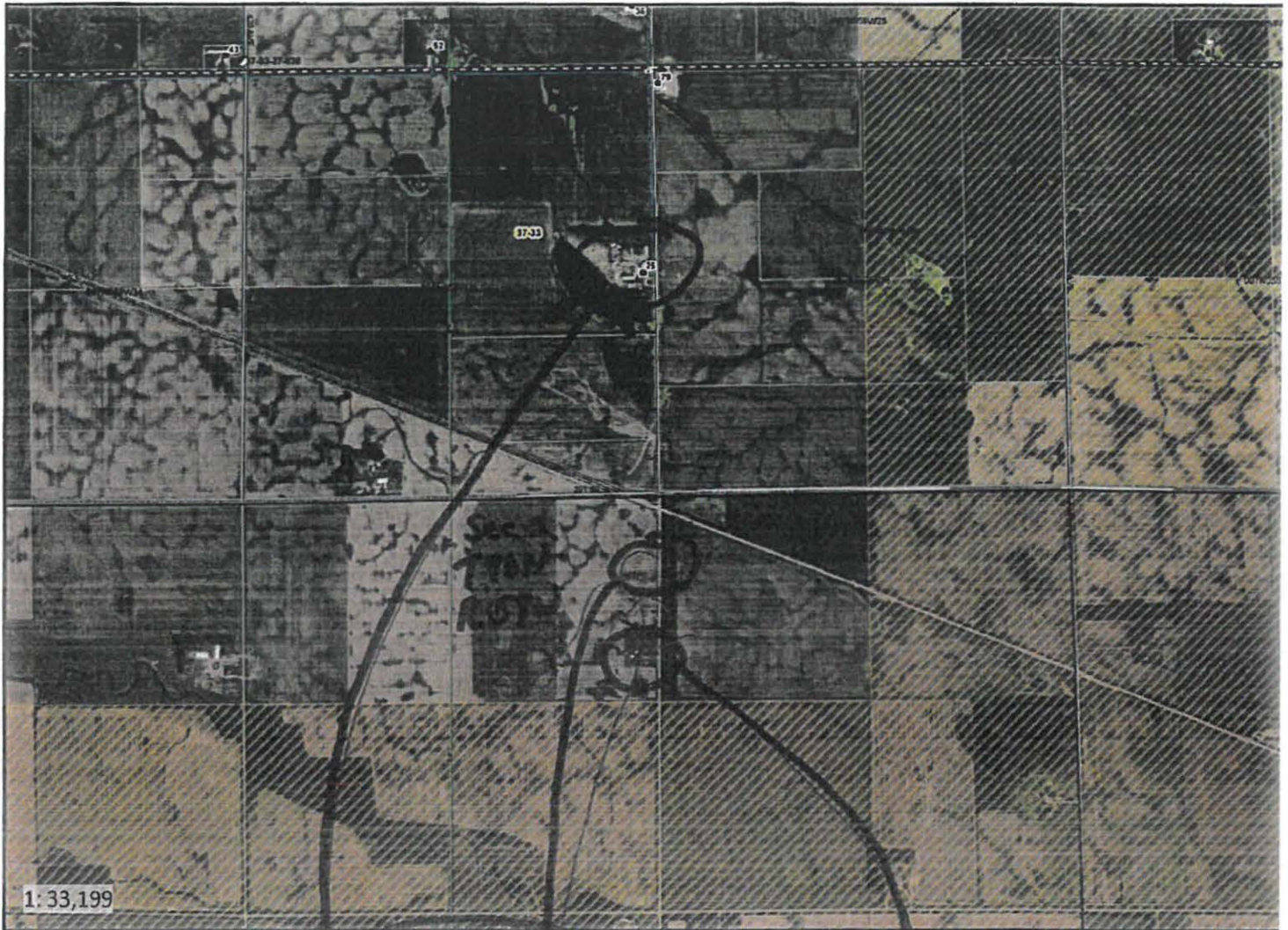
