It has been brought to my attention that Ms. Zita Bialas has requested electric service for a residence at location 27307 404th Avenue, Parkston, South Dakota. Her service request will be in the Southeast quarter (SE1/4) of the Southeast quarter (SE1/4) of Section 36 of T100N-R62W of Washington Township in Douglas County, South Dakota. The location of this service will be in Douglas Electric Cooperative, Inc's., (Douglas) service territory as set forth and established by the South Dakota Public Utility Commission (SDPUC).

Southeastern Electric Cooperative, Inc., (Southeastern) would be required to extend electric service approximately 107 feet West along 404th Avenue and approximately 203 feet north of 270th Street into the property of Ms. Bialas as noted on the attached Staking Sheet. The line extension fee from Southeastern for this service is \$1,400 (\$400 new service fee + \$5 per 200 amp of service \$1,000) in accordance with our standard line extension policy. It is Southeastern's understanding that Douglas will need to extend electric lines more than 1 mile to provide electric service to Ms. Bialas and that your aid to construction may be higher than the cost indicated here by Southeastern. Based on our discussions with Ms. Bialas she is willing to allow Southeastern to serve her electric load at the specific location noted above. Southeastern did receive a letter from Ms. Bialas approving this transfer prior to moving forward with submission of this material to the SDPUC for approval.

Southeastern is requesting from Douglas your permission to serve this electric load for Ms. Bialas at the location listed above. We fully understand that this service is in your service territory and will await written notification from you. Once Southeastern receives written notification to serve this load from Douglas we will work with you on the necessary paperwork for filing for permission from the SDPUC on this issue.
