MOTION TO WITHDRAW

Comes now, Black Hills Power, Inc. d/b/a Black Hills Energy (“Black Hills Power” or the “Applicant”), by and through undersigned counsel, pursuant to ARSD 20:10:1:2.04, for its Motion to Withdraw, without prejudice. In support of this motion, Black Hills Power states as follows:

Black Hills Power filed the instant docket on April 2, 2024 requesting authority to revise its existing tariff to include costs related to the study of balancing authority options.

Due to additional changes needed in the Application, Black Hills Power has discussed the need for additional changes with Staff and Staff is in agreement with filing this Motion to Withdraw and the filing of an updated Application.

The dismissal of this docket does not impact any parties’ rights to assert issues as identified in this docket.


Black Hills Power will file a new application simultaneously with this Motion to Withdraw.
