Dennis Burnham (hereinafter "Burnham"), through his counsel, Mark D. O'Leary, petitions the Commission to allow his intervention in the above referenced matter, and states as follows:

- Burnham owned the single family residence located at 1616 Bridle Drive, Mitchell, South Dakota. Mr.
   Burnham's home was totally destroyed as a result of the March 8, 2007, explosion.
- 2. Burnham has previously advised Commission Staff of his interest regarding the pipeline explosion.
- 3. Burnham reasonably believes that he could be adversely affected if he is not permitted to intervene as he would have no meaningful role in the investigation; including selection of independent experts should destructive testing become necessary during the investigation.

- 4. Burnham, or those acting on his behalf, have retained both a cause & origin expert and a professional engineer to assist him in the investigation of this explosion. Burnham's retained experts should be allowed to participate in joint testing, examinations, and inspections, as the need arises, in order that the interests of Burnham may be protected.
- 5. As a result of the loss of his property, the interests of Burnham in the investigation are peculiar to him and distinguishable from the interests of the public at large.

WHEREFORE, Burnham respectfully petitions the Commission to allow him to intervene in this matter.
