Gemini Companies. Inc. is responsible for the payment of phone bills for Basic Public Access Lines to pay telephones located in South Dakota, North Dekota, Minnesota, and Iowa, These lines are provided by US West in all of the above-mentioned states and by eight other companies in South Dakota. The eight other phone companies, and US West in the other states, sell service to payphone providers on a flat-rated basis. InSouth Dakota, US West requires the use of a metered, or message-based rate in areas where their equipment allows them to measure service. The effect of this requirement is that our average monthly US West phone bills in South Dakota are \$10 to \$14 higher than our US West monthly phone bills in the other states and \$22 per month higher than our monthly average of phone bills from the eight other South Dakota companies. In each case the service received is identical: basic disl tone with certain screening and blocking features.

On July 28, 1997, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint from Gemini Companies, Inc. (Gemini) against U S WEST Communications, Inc. (U S WEST) regarding the cost of basic public access lines. Gemini requested that the Commission mandate the use of a flat rate and eliminate the measured service rate. Gemini alleged that the effect of U S WEST's measured rate is to cause higher bills for Gemini in South Dakota as compared to surrounding states. At its regularly scheduled meeting of September 9, 1997, the Commission deferred action on this matter.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08:01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unleavful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint.

On September 25, 1997, at its duly noticed meeting, the Commission reviewed the complaint, as well as comments from Gemini and staff.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 49-13 and 49-31 and ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09. In Docket TC97-006, the Commission did not mandate the use of a flat rate for U S WEST's Smart Public Access Lines. Consistent with that decision, the Commission voted unanimously to find no probable cause. It is therefore

ORDERED, that there is no probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice, or omission.
