

#### GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE

#### 1.0 APPLICABILITY

This tariff contains the descriptions and regulations applicable to the furnishing of service or facilities for telecommunications services furnished by Black Hills FiberCom, Inc., which does business under the assumed name of Black Hills FiberCom. Principle business offices are currently at 2045 Samco Road, Rapid City, SD 57702. This tariff is on file with the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission). Copies may be inspected, during normal business hours, at the Company's principle place of business. Due to the early stage of this business, customers are advised to make an appointment prior to visiting the Black Hills FiberCom offices.

#### 2.0 PURPOSE OF THE COMPANY

Black Hills FiberCom provides telecommunications services as described herein to residential, commercial, and governmental customers. Black Hills FiberCom is a switching, facilities-based provider of directly connected and resale telecommunications services (network and switching facilities are under construction and resale arrangements are being negotiated). Black Hills FiberCom intends to offer local and long-distance telephone, high-speed data and video, high-speed Internet access and distance learning services, as well as, cable television service. In addition, Black Hills FiberCom may lease customer specific equipment necessary to receive service from the network. Black Hills FiberCom intends to provide high quality services that meet or exceed industry reliability standards. Services will be available on a full-time basis, twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week, to customers within the geographic boundaries of the state of South Dakota.

#### 3.0 AVAILABILITY

Black Hills FiberCom is authorized by the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission to offer local telecommunications services in those areas in South Dakota where US WEST Communications, Inc., is the incumbent local exchange carrier. A key element of the Black Hills FiberCom business plan is the construction of a switched fiber optic and hybrid fiber coaxial communications network to serve customers within the following communities:

#### 4.0 LIMITATIONS

- 4.1 Black Hills FiberCom reserves the right to discontinue service, or limit the use of service for non-payment of charges; or when the customer's use of a service becomes or is in violation of the law or the provisions of the tartif.
- 4.2 Black Hills FiberCom offers service to all customers equally and on a nondiscriminatory basis. Service is offered subject to the availability of the facilities and services of Black Hills FiberCom.

#### 5.0 LIABILITIES OF COMPANY

- 5.1 Black Hills FiberCorn will endeavor to provide continuous service but does not guarantee uninterrupted service. Black Hills FiberCorn will not be responsible for any loss or damage resulting from the interruption or disturbance of service for any cause other than gross negligence of Black Hills FiberCorn. Black Hills FiberCorn will not be liable for any loss of profits or other consequential damages resulting from the use of service or any interruption or disturbance of service.
- 5.2 Black Hills FiberCom assumes no liability for damages caused by interruption, delays, defects in the transmission of customer's telecommunications traffic due to acts of God, fire, war, civil disturbance, act of government, or due to any other causes beyond Black Hills FiberCom's control.
- 5.3 Black Hills FiberCom's liability for such damages, not caused by willful misconduct by Black Hills FiberCom or it's agents, in no case will exceed an amount equivalent to the proportionate charge to the customer for the period during which such interruptions, delays, mistakes, or defect in transmission occurred.

#### 6.0 INTERRUPTION OF SERVICE

- 6.1 It shall be the customer's obligation to notify Black Hills FiberCom of any interruption of service for credit. The customer should check to insure that any action or trouble within the customer's control or equipment does not cause the trouble.
- 6.3 Service outage due to such failure as caused by or occurs due to Black Hills FiberCom's control are limited to a credit for the outage as defined in Section 5.

#### 7.0 DEPOSITS

Black Hills FiberCom does not require a deposit from its customers, but reserves the right to require such a deposit, not to exceed two months estimated, or if known, two month's historical charges for service, whenever the financial circumstances of the customer so warrants. Black Hills FiberCom will return any deposits required, plus the applicable 7% simple interest, after one year of consistent timely payments by the customer. Up to the full amount of deposit shall be applied to any charges unpaid after thirty days from the invoice date. Should a deposit be required of the customer, the customer may choose a paid-by-bank payment option in lieu of making a deposit.

#### 8.0 PAYMENT AND BILLING

- 8.1 Service is provided and billed on a monthly or annual basis. Usage charges are billed in arrears. Recurring fixed charges are billed monthly in advance.
- 8.2 All billings presented for payment by Black Hills FiberCom will show the type of service rendered, the related charges, and the total bill for such services.
- 8.3 Bills are payable and due upon receipt. A late charge calculated at a rate of one and one-half percent per month will be charged on any amount unpaid after thirty days from rendering.
- 8.4 A Non-Sufficient Funds Check Charge of \$30.00 will be added to the customer's current amount due, if a check for payment of service is returned for any reason, such as non-sufficient funds or closed account.
- 8.5 If Black Hills FiberCorn service has been discontinued for nonpayment, the customer will be required to pay any unpaid balance due to Black Hills FiberCom before service is restored.
- 8.6 If a customer's service is disconnected for nonpayment of sum due to Black Hills FiberCom, and customer wishes to reconnect service, a one-time charge of \$50.00 for the re-establishment of service will be billed to the customer. Payment of the re-establishment charge and any outstanding amounts will be due in full prior to reconnection of service.

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) order states that no later than April 22, 1999, all Local Exchange Companies (LECs) must file intraLATA toll dialing parity plans with the state regulatory commission for each state in which the LEC provides telephone exchange service if a plan has not yet been filed with such state commission. Once a state commission has approved a plan, the LEC must implement its plan no later than 30 days after the date on which the plan is approved. If the state commission has not acted on the plan by June 22, 1999, the LEC must file the plan with the Common Carrier Bureau of the FCC. Pursuant to the FCC order, LECs shall file an intraLATA toll dialing plan by April 22, 1999; interested persons or entities may file comments on the plans no later than May 7, 1999; and LECs may file rebuttal comments no later than May 17, 1999.

On March 25, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission), in accordance with SDCL 49-31-3 and ARSD 20:10:24:02, 20:10:24:04.01, 20:10:32:03 and 20:10:32:08, received an application from Black Hills FiberCom, Inc. to transfer its certificate of authority to Black Hills FiberCom, Inc. was granted authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services statewide and local telecommunications services within U S WEST Communications, Inc.'s service areas on August 5, 1998.

On April 1, 1999, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of April 16, 1999, to interested individuals and entities. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed and at its regularly scheduled April 26, 1999, meeting, the Commission considered Black Hills FiberCom, Inc.'s request for a transfer of its certificate of authority to Black Hills FiberCom, L.L.C. (ommission Staff recommended granting the transfer of the certificate of authority, subject to rural safeguards.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Chapter 49-31, specifically 49-31-3 and 49-31-75 and ARSD 20:10:24:02, 20:10:24:03, 20:10:24:04.01, 20:10:32:03 and 20:10:32:08. The Commission finds that Black Hills FiberCom, L.L.C. has met the legal requirements established for the granting of a certificate of authority. Black Hills FiberCom, L.L.C. has, in accordance with SDCL 49-31-1, demonstrated sufficient technical, financial and managerial capabilities to offer telecommunications services in South Dakota.

The Commission approves Black Hills FiberCom, Inc.'s application to transfer its certificate of authority to Black Hills FiberCom, L.L.C., subject to rural safeguards. The certificate of authority for Black Hills FiberCom, L.L.C. shall authorize it to offer local exchange services in those areas in South Dakota where U S WEST Communications, Inc., is the incumbent local exchange carrier. In the future, should Black Hills FiberCom, L.L.C. choose to provide local exchange services statewide, with respect to rural telephone companies, Black Hills FiberCom, L.L.C. will have to come before the Commission in another proceeding before being able to provide local service in that rural service area pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 253(f) which allows the Commission to require a company that seeks to provide service in a rural service area to meet the requirements in 47 U.S.C. § 214(e)(1) for designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier. In addition, the granting of statewide certification will not affect the exemptions, suspensions, and modifications for rural telephone companies found in 47 U.S.C. § 251(f). It is therefore

ORDERED, that Black Hills FiberCom, Inc.'s application for a transfer of its certificate of authority to Black Hills FiberCom, L.L.C. to provide telecommunications services, including local exchange services, is granted; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that Black Hills FiberCom, L.L.C. shall file informational copies of tariff changes with the Commission as the changes occur; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that the Commission shall authorize Black Hills FiberCom, L.L.C. to offer its local services in those areas in South Dakota where U S WEST Communications, Inc., is the incumbent local exchange carrier.
