2. Reduces the non-recurring charge when a DSS facility is provisioned on a DS3 from \$900 to \$325.
3. Introduces a Rollover and a Signaling Design Change Charge for DSS and UAS to cover these special functions rather than assessing the current non-recurring charges.

I have also attached another document which she believes will answer your questions - *Data Request Responses*.

The non-recurring costs shown on Attachment A are Total Service Long Run Incremental costs (TSLRIC). In addition to these costs are Directly Attributable Costs and Common Costs. The contribution shown is the difference between the price and TSLRIC. This contribution number then represents the amount that goes toward covering Directly Attributable Costs and Common Costs. This contribution amount may also contribute towards some profit. The TSLRIC does include costs associated with some elements for which there is a cost of money.
