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Dear Ms. Bonrud:

On behalf of its member companies, attached for filing with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) are revised pages of the Local Exchange Carriers Association (LECA) Tariff No. 1 (Attachment 1). The purpose of these revisions is to implement changes in rates as necessitated by revisions in member companies' revenue requirements.

Under state statute (SDCL 49-13-12.2) the revised rates included in the attached tariff pages are proposed to be effective August 1, 2005 and are calculated in the attached spreadsheet (Attachment 2). The table below shows each of the current and the proposed rates by rate element and by jurisdiction.

The total decrease in the combined annual revenue requirement is \$299,662 combined with a total decrease in minutes of use, equals an average increase per access minute of \$.0113 for each of the interexchange carriers.
