REQUEST FOR SUSPENSION OF TARIFF

Midcontinent Communications ("Midcontinent") by its undersigned counsel requests that the Commission suspend the tariff of the Local Exchange Carriers Association ("LECA") pursuant to SDCL § 49-31-12.4, as follows:

1. Midcontinent is a certificated communications company under the jurisdiction of the Commission.

2. LECA has filed with the Commission a letter and supporting documentation seeking to establish increased switched access rates for its members. Midcontinent has filed a petition to intervene in that docket. The intervention is based upon the proposition that the switched access rates currently charged by LECA members are among the highest in the nation and are significantly above the average national access rates. Upon information and belief, it is Midcontinent's understanding that AT&T and MCI have filed petitions to intervene on essentially the same basis.

3. Midcontinent has a direct interest in the outcome of this proceeding. As a certificated local exchange carrier and long distance carrier, Midcontinent and its customers are subject to the payment of switched access charges in order to do business with LECA and its members. Midcontinent has alleged in its petition to intervene that a denial of its petition will result in the inability of Midcontinent to question the basis for LECA's revised, increased switched access rates, and that approval of LECA's proposed access rates without scrutiny would be detrimental to the public interest and likely to result in a miscarriage of justice by further perpetuating artificially high switched access rates for LECA and its members. 4. Midcontinent has engaged the services of experts to review the Commission's cost model as established by its rules and believes that the cost model is outdated and inaccurately reflects the underlying cost support for the switched access rates resulting from application of the cost model.

5. For the foregoing reasons, any implementation of the proposed rates prior to their scrutiny will further drive up switched access costs for Midcontinent and its subscribers which are already artificially high.

WHEREFORE Midcontinent prays that the Commission suspend the tariff as provided in SDCL § 41-31-12.4 and permit the proceeding to go to hearing.
