- 1. I am of legal age, competent and have the authority to give this affidavit.
- 2. I am an attorney of record for Armour Independent Telephone Company, Bridgewater-Canistota Telephone Company, Golden West Telecommunications Cooperative, Inc., Kadoka Telephone Company, Sioux Valley Telephone Company, Union Telephone Company, and Vivian Telephone Company (collectively the "Golden West Companies") in this proceeding.
- 3. On July 25, 2006, I received an electronic file of a letter on the letterhead of the South Dakota Bureau of Administration, Office of Hearing Examiners (the "OHE"), signed by Julie M. Johnson stating that Julie M. Johnson had been appointed the Hearing Examiner in this proceeding.

- 4. On July 28, 2006, I received another letter, also on the letterhead of the OHE, signed by Leo Disburg and stating: "The above-referenced matter has been assigned to Julie M. Johnson, Hearing Examiner. In the event Ms. Johnson is unavailable on the scheduled hearing date, Hillary Brady may be appointed in her place."
- 5. SDCL § 1-26D-10 grants the absolute right to any part to a matter for which a hearing examiner from the OHE has been appointed to file an affidavit "requesting the appointment of another hearing examiner." The communication referenced in the preceding paragraph states that Ms. Johnson's appointment is conditioned upon her "availability" on the scheduled hearing date. Thus, it appears that the OHE has made an appointment of a primary and a secondary hearing examiner or a conditional appointment. No such procedure is provided in SDCL Chapter 1-26D.
- 6. Pursuant to SDCL §1-26D-10, the Golden West Companies request that the Bureau of Administration, Office of Hearing Examiners appoint another hearing examiner in place of Ms. Johnson in each of the above-referenced dockets, and to the extent that Mr. Disburg's letter constitutes Ms. Brady as a secondary or substitute hearing examiner if and when Ms. Johnson is "unavailable", the Golden West Companies further request appointment of another hearing examiner in place of Ms. Brady as Ms. Johnson's substitute hearing examiner.
- 7.
