1-3. Provide a working electronic copy and the results of the cost study performed as alluded to in paragraph 4 of the Petition and/or the response to question 2 above.

RESPONSE. Midcontinent requests CONFIDENTIAL treatment of 20:10:01:41. this Response pursuant to ARSD Exhibit Α ("MIDCONTINENT LECA COST STUDY.XLS") provides a CONFIDENTIAL working electronic copy of the "LECA model" Excel® spreadsheet that OSI devised in the course of its cost study modeling efforts on behalf of Midcontinent. The spreadsheet's primary outputs are the Access Rate Per Minute values appearing at Sheet A, Line 51, including Common Line, Local Switching, and Common Transport cost elements as well as their sum, labeled Part 36 While the spreadsheet shows values for those outputs, they should not be treated as cost study "results" because they are based on preliminary inputs, assumptions, cost allocations, and methodological choices that have not been validated or finalized to date. See Response to RFI 1-2.

1-9. Provide Midco's 2005, 2006 and 2007 to date South Dakota intrastate switched access revenue and minutes of use by year.
