APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY FOR STANDARD TANDEM LLC

Pursuant to Sections 20:10:32:03 and 20:10:24:02 of the Administrative Rules of South Dakota, Standard Tandem LLC hereby applies for a certificate of authority from the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") to provide local exchange services and interexchange long distance services in the state of South Dakota. Standard Tandem submits the following information in support of this Application:

(2) A description of the legal and organizational structure of the applicant's Company:

Standard Tandem LLC is a California limited liability company organized on January 9, 2019. A copy of the Applicant's Articles of Organization is included as **Exhibit 1** to the application.

(3) The name under which applicant will provide local exchange services if different than in subdivision (1) of this section:

The Applicant will provide services under the name shown in Question 1.

(4) The location of the applicant's principal office, if any, in this state and the name and address of its current registered agent, if applicable:

Standard Tandem does not have a principal office in South Dakota.

A copy of the Applicant's certificate of authority to transact business in South Dakota from the Secretary of State is included as **Exhibit 2** to the application.

(6) A description of the applicant's experience providing any telecommunications services in South Dakota or in other jurisdictions, including the types of services provided, and the dates and nature of state or federal authorization to provide the services:

Standard Tandem LLC has not previously provided telecommunications services in South Dakota. It is currently authorized to provide service in Iowa.

Standard Tandem LLC is in the process of filing applications in Colorado, New York, and Washington.

(7) Names and addresses of applicant's affiliates, subsidiaries, and parent organizations, if any:

Standard Tandem does not have any affiliates, subsidiaries or parent organizations.

- (8) A list and specific description of the types of services the applicant seeks to offer and how the services will be provided including:
 - (a) Information indicating the classes of customers the applicant intends to serve;

Standard Tandem will provide services to business customers.

(b) Information indicating the extent to and time-frame by which applicant will provide service through the use of its own facilities, the purchase of unbundled network elements, or resale;

Applicant intends to provide service as soon as practicable upon grant of this Application. However, initiation of operations will first require negotiation of interconnection agreements with other service providers, including successful completion of the installation and/or procurement of any facilities needed for Applicant to provide services in South Dakota. As the time periods required to complete such actions may vary, a firm timeline for the initiation of service has not yet been established.

(8) A list and specific description of the types of services the applicant seeks to offer and how the services will be provided including: (Cont'd)

- (c) Applicant does not currently own facilities or property in South Dakota but will acquire or construct facilities in the state as necessary to provide its services. To facilitate deployment of services, Applicant intends to enter into interconnection agreements and/or other agreements with other service providers as permitted under the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996,47 U.S.c. § 251(c).
- (d) Information identifying the types of services it seeks authority to provide by reference to the general nature of the service;

Standard Tandem proposes to offer wholesale and retail competitive telecommunications service, including local exchange, interexchange, and exchange access services, within the State of South Dakota using its own facilities and services available from other facilities-based carriers.

(9) A service area map or narrative description indicating with particularity the geographic area proposed to be served by the applicant:

The Applicant requests authority to provide service throughout the state of South Dakota, excluding those areas served by a rural telephone company. Standard Tandem's service areas and exchanges will mirror those established of its underlying carrier. Standard Tandem concurs in the service maps of those carriers, as currently filed with the Commission and as subsequently redefined. For these reasons, Standard Tandem requests that it be exempted from the requirement to provide a service area map in its filing.

(10) Information regarding the technical competence of the applicant to provide its proposed local exchange services including:

(a) A description of the education and experience of the applicant's management personnel who will oversee the proposed local exchange services; and

Attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** is a description of the education and experience of Standard Tandem's management personnel.

 - (b) Information regarding policies, personnel, or arrangements made by the applicant which demonstrates the applicant's ability to respond to customer complaints and inquiries promptly and to perform facility and equipment maintenance necessary to ensure compliance with any commission quality of service requirements;

Applicant is responsible for all customer inquiries and complaints. All inquiries may be accepted 24 hours a day, seven days a week at the following:

(11) Information explaining how the applicant will provide customers with access to emergency services such as 911 or enhanced 911, operator services, interexchange services, directory assistance, and telecommunications relay services:

Standard Tandem will enter into interconnection agreements with CenturyLink QC (Qwest) and other certificated LECs. Under such agreements, Standard Tandem's customers will be able to access emergency services such as 911 or enhanced 911. Such calls will be routed through the underlying carrier to the appropriate emergency agency serving the originating location. Access to local operator services, directory assistance and telecommunications relay services will also be made available.

(12) For the most recent 12 month period, financial statements of the applicant consisting of balance sheets, income statements, and cash flow statements. The applicant shall provide audited financial statements, if available:

Standard Tandem has the financing and capital necessary to provide services as proposed in this Application. The Applicant's financial information is provided in **Exhibit 4**, which is submitted under confidential seal.

- (13) Information detailing the following matters associated with interconnection to provide proposed local exchange services:
 - (a) The identity of all local exchange carriers with which the applicant plans to interconnect.

Standard Tandem will enter into interconnection agreements with CenturyLink QC (Qwest) and other certificated LECs as Customer demand warrants.

(b) The likely timing of initiation of interconnection service and a statement as to when negotiations for interconnection started or when negotiations are likely to start.

Standard Tandem anticipates negotiating the interconnection agreements concurrent with the processing of this application.

 - (c) A copy of any request for interconnection made by the applicant to any local exchange carrier.

Standard Tandem plans to initially market its services to wholesale customers and to business customers. Marketing of services will be done through its direct sales staff.

(15) If the applicant is seeking authority to provide local exchange service in the service area of a rural telephone company, the date by which the applicant expects to meet the service obligations imposed pursuant to § 20:10:32:15 and applicant's plans for meeting the service obligations:

Standard Tandem is not seeking to provide service in rural territories.

Standard Tandem is a start-up company and in the process of filing applications and registrations in Colorado, New York, and Washington. It is currently certified in IA and has never been denied registration of certification.

(18) Information concerning how the applicant plans to bill and collect charges from customers who subscribe to its proposed local exchange services;

Standard Tandem will bill customers directly. Customer payments will be made directly to the Company, and the Company will have no payment centers in South Dakota.

(19) Information concerning the applicant's policies relating to solicitation of new customers and a description of the efforts the applicant shall use to prevent the unauthorized switching of local service customers by the applicant, its employees, or agents;

Standard Tandem utilizes a direct sales approach to its marketing efforts. The Company does not utilize any form of multilevel marketing in the sale of its services. The Company uses a written LOA to prevent the unauthorized switching of local service customers.

(20) The number and nature of complaints filed against the applicant with any state or federal commission regarding the unauthorized switching of a customer's telecommunications provider and the act of charging customers for services that have not been ordered;

Standard Tandem has never had a complaint filed against it for the unauthorized switching of a customer's local exchange service.

(21) Information concerning how the applicant will make available to any person information concerning the applicant's current rates, terms, and conditions for all of its telecommunications services;

Standard Tandem will post product offerings on its website at www.standardtandem.com, and all customers will enter into written or electronic contracts for products and services. The Company's switched access services tariff will be filed with the Commission.

(22) Information concerning how the applicant will notify a customer of any materially adverse change to any rate, term, or condition of any telecommunications service being provided to the customer. The notification must be made at least thirty days in advance of the change;

Standard Tandem will notify customers directly or via bill insert, thirty days in advance of the change, as warranted by the nature of the change.

(23) A written request for waiver of those rules believed to be inapplicable;

Standard Tandem's Federal Tax Identification Number is 32-0589321.

Standard Tandem's application for South Dakota sales tax number is currently being processed and will be provided in a separate filing upon receipt.
