On October 8, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by William P. and Debra L. Lange, Rapid City, South Dakota (Complainant), against America's Tele-Network Corp. (ATN) regarding unauthorized switching of services.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint. This matter was scheduled for a probable cause determination at the Commission's regularly scheduled October 19, 1999, meeting and at that meeting, the Commission unanimously voted to find probable cause.

On November 23, 1999, the Commission Staff received a letter from ATN indicating that there had been a resolution of the matter and that the case should be considered closed.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-7.2, 49-31-7.3, 49-31-7.4, 49-31-10, 49-31-11, 49-31-38, 49-31-38.1, 49-31-38.2, 49-31-38.3, 49-31-89 through 49-31-97, inclusive, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:34.

On December 14, 1999, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Upon recommendation of Commission Staff, the Commission voted to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the complaint shall be dismissed and the docket closed.
