On October 9, 2002, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Brenda and Mark DeGraw, Sioux Falls, South Dakota (Complainant), against Qwest Corporation (Qwest) and MCIWorldCom (MCI) regarding contract and billing dispute.

On October 17, 2002, the complaint was faxed to Qwest and MCI. Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:09, Qwest and MCI were notified that they must satisfy the complaint or file answers in writing with the Commission by November 6, 2002. On November 6, 2002, the Commission received an answer and motion to dismiss from MCI and a motion to dismiss from Qwest. Commission Staff was informed that settlement had been reached in this matter.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-7.2, 49-31-7.3, 49-31-7.4, 49-31-10, 49-31-11, 49-31-38, 49-31-38.1, 49-31-38.2, 49-31-38.3, 49-31-89 through 49-31-97, inclusive, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:34.

On January 16, 2003, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Upon recommendation of Commission Staff, the Commission voted to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the complaint shall be dismissed and the docket closed.
