(FiberCom) regarding its late payment charge. On November 24, 2003, the Commission received an Answer and Motion to Dismiss from FiberCom. On December 2, 2003, the Commission received Complainant's Response to FiberCom's Answer and Motion to Dismiss. On December 16, 2003, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Complainant did not appear, and the Commission voted unanimously to grant the motion to dismiss, to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. On December 24, 2003, the Commission received a Petition for Rehearing from Complainant. On December 30, 2003, the Commission received an email filing by FiberCom stipulating that FiberCom had no objection to the Petition for Rehearing.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-7.2, 49-31-7.3, 49-31-7.4, 49-31-10, 49-31-11, 49-31-38, 49-31-38.1, 49-31-38.2, 49-31-38.3, 49-31-89 through 49-31-97, inclusive, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:34.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Complainant's Petition for Rehearing will be considered by the Commission at its regular meeting on January 6, 2004 at 1:30 P.M. CST, in Room 464, State Capitol Building, 500 East Capitol, Pierre, South Dakota.
