IN THE MATTER OF THE FILING BY MIDAMERICAN ENERGY COMPANY FOR APPROVAL OF REVISED RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL CUSTOMER INFORMATION PAMPHLETS ORDER APPROVING CHANGES TO CUSTOMER INFORMATION PAMPHLETS GE04-001

On November 15, 2004, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) requesting approval of changes to customer information contained in pamphlets distributed to new customers. The company has updated the gas portion of the pamphlets to reflect rate changes resulting from the recent rate case - Docket NG04-001, the recently approved Interruptible Gas Rate Plan approved in Docket NG04-003, updated information regarding MidAmerican's Purchased Gas Adjustment and Energy Cost Adjustment sections of the pamphlets and some text changes which will provide some clarification to customers on policies and procedures.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:16:02, a utility must submit a copy of customer information to the Commission for approval before it can be distributed.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of December 14, 2004, the Commission considered approval of the changes. Commission Staff recommended approval of the changes.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-34A-4, 49-34A-6, 49-34A-8, 49-34A-10, 49-34A-11 and ARSD 20:10:16:02. Further, the Commission finds that the customer information pamphlets are in the public interest and shall be approved. It is therefore

ORDERED, that MidAmerican's above mentioned changes to the customer information pamphlets are hereby approved.
