On April 16, 2015, MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) filed with the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) its Report on 2014 Economic Development Activities and Proposed 2015 Budget (Report). The Report includes MidAmerican's report on 2014 economic development activities, actual expenditures for 2014, and planned budget for 2015. MidAmerican requests Commission approval of the 2014 report and proposed 2015 budget.

On April 23, 2015, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of May 8, 2015, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed. On May 12, 2015, MidAmerican filed its responses to Commission staff's data requests.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-34A, specifically SDCL 49-34A-4 and 49-34A-6.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on June 11, 2015, the Commission considered this matter. After review of the Report, the Commission found the activities and contributions set forth therein to be just and reasonable and voted unanimously to approve MidAmerican's Report on 2014 Economic Development Activities and Proposed 2015 Budget. It is therefore

ORDERED, that MidAmerican's Report on 2014 Economic Development Activities and Proposed 2015 Budget are approved as filed.
