All certified long distance resellers are not required to obtain a Primary Interstate Carrier (PIC) number with which to identify them as a customer's long distance carrier. The Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has fielded a number of concerns regarding the difficulties local exchange carriers and customers are experiencing when trying to identify a customer's long distance carrier. Commission Staff has also encountered difficulties when attempting to obtain such information.

On April 15, 1997, at a regularly scheduled meeting, Commission Staff recommended that the Commission open a docket in this matter.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-13 and 49-31. The Commission unanimously voted to open a docket on this matter. It is therefore

ORDERED that a docket be opened to investigate the practice of long distance resellers operating within the state of South Dakota without an identifying PIC number.
