On March 28, 2005, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Qwest Corporation (Qwest) for approval of revisions to its Access Service Tariff. The purpose of the revisions is to introduce clarifying language for Common Channel Signaling Access Capability (CCSAC). According to Qwest, "This language was developed and agreed to in discussions with AT&T. These changes have no customer cost or rate impact but all affected customers are being sent an individual letter notifying them of the filing."

On March 31, 2005, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of April 15, 2005, to interested individuals and entities. No parties sought intervention.
