On May 24, 2007, the Commission received for approval a filing of a Business Escalation Agreement between Qwest Corporation (Qwest) and Verizon Business Network Services, Inc. (Verizon).

On May 31, 2007, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of this filing to interested individuals and entities. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the parties' request for approval had until June 13, 2007, to do so. No comments were filed. On July 6, 2007, Qwest requested that the agreement be withdrawn.

At its duly noticed August 7, 2007, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the withdrawal of the agreement between Qwest and Verizon. Commission Staff recommended approval of the withdrawal.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31, specifically 49-31-81, and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. Upon review of the request for withdrawal, the Commission voted to approve it. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the withdrawal of the agreement which is the subject of this docket.
