Company officials are advised to be familiar with South Dakota Codified Laws and Administrative Rules applicable to the regulation of telecommunications services in South Dakota, including our slamming and cramming laws and rules. These statutes and rules describe the required reporting and corresponding deadlines for your company's business in South Dakota. Annual Report and Gross Receipts Tax Fund Assessment forms must be submitted to the Commission annually. Please be advised that the failure to remit the Annual Report or Gross Receipts Tax Fund Assessment forms or to pay the gross receipts tax may result in the revocation of your Certificate of Authority.
