On November 26, 2008, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a request from Bullseye Telecom, Inc. (Bullseye) for approval of an extension of its exemption from the requirement to develop intrastate switched access rates based on company specific costs. On December 10, 2008 and December 19, 2008, the Commission received revised tariff pages from Bullseye.

On November 30, 2008, the Commission considered Bullseye's request for approval of an extension of its exemption from establishing switched access rates based on company specific costs. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-31-18, 49-31-19, and ARSD 20:10:27:11. The Commission voted to grant an extension of its exemption. It is therefore

ORDERED, that Bullseye is approved for an extension of its exemption from establishing company specific cost-based switched access rates and allowed Bullseye to modify its switched access tariff so long as Bullseye's intrastate switched access rate is equal to or less than that of the ILEC Qwest intrastate switched access rate or until the Commission shall otherwise order.
