On May 19, 2010, the Commission received a filing for approval of a wireline interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation (Qwest) and Neutral Tandem, Inc. (Neutral Tandem) for the state of South Dakota. Any party wishing to comment may do so by filing written comments with the Commission and the parties to the Agreement no later than June 8, 2010. The Commission did not receive any comments on this matter

At its June 15, 2010, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the agreement between Qwest and Neutral Tandem. Commission Staff recommended its approval.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31, and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. In accordance with 47 U.S.C § 252(e)(2), the Commission found that the agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement and the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the wireline interconnection agreement between Qwest and Neutral Tandem.
