On June 18, 2010, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from TDS Long Distance (TDS) for a Certificate of Authority for the state of South Dakota. TDS plans to provide facilities-based and resold interexchange service in South Dakota. On June 18, 2010, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of July 9, 2010, to interested individuals and entities. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on August 10, 2010, the Commission considered TDS's request for a certificate of authority. Commission Staff recommended granting a certificate of authority.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31, specifically 49-31-3 and ARSD 20:10:24:02. The Commission finds that TDS has met the legal requirements established for the granting of a certificate of authority. TDS has, in accordance with SDCL 49-31-3, demonstrated sufficient technical, financial and managerial capabilities to offer telecommunications services in South Dakota.

The Commission approves TDS's application for a certificate of authority. It is therefore

ORDERED, that TDS's application for a certificate of authority to provide facilities-based and resold interexchange service is granted. It is further

ORDERED, that this order constitutes TDS's certificate of authority as described above.
