On April 17, 2012, Sprint Communications Company L.P. (Sprint) filed for Commission approval of revisions to its South Dakota Access Service Tariff No. 3 with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission). The revisions add clarifying language regarding the Rating of Toll VoIP-PSTN Traffic and to add Percent VoIP Usage (PVU) factor language. On April 30, 2012, Sprint filed a request to withdraw the filing.

On April 19, 2012, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of May 4, 2012 to interested individuals and entities. No parties sought intervention.

At its May 8, 2012, meeting, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-31. The Commission voted unanimously to grant the request to withdraw the tariff filing. It is therefore

ORDERED, that Sprint's request to withdraw its tariff filing is granted.
