IN THE MATTER OF THE FILING BY BROADVOX-CLEC, LLC FOR APPROVAL OF REVISIONS TO TARIFF NO. 1 ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION AND SUSPENDING TARIFF

On December 3, 2013, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from Broadvox-CLEC, LLC (Broadvox). This filing proposes to modify language in its switched access tariff.

On December 5, 2013, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of December 20, 2013, to interested individuals and entities. On December 20, 2013, AT&T Corp. (AT&T) filed a Petition to Intervene and Request to Suspend Tariff and Investigate (Petition). On December 30, 2013, Broadvox filed a letter stating that Broadvox and AT&T agreed that Broadvox shall have until January 24, 2014, to file its response to AT&T's Petition. On January 24, 2014, Broadvox filed an answer to AT&T's Petition.

At its January 27, 2014, meeting, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-31 and ARSD 20:10:01:15.05. Commission staff recommended that the Commission grant the Petition of AT&T and suspend the tariff for 120 days beyond the proposed January 4, 2014, effective date. After discussion, the Commission found that the Petition demonstrated good cause to grant intervention and voted unanimously to grant intervention to AT&T and to suspend the effective date of Broadvox's tariff for 60 days beyond the proposed effective date. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Petition to Intervene of AT&T is hereby granted. It is further

ORDERED, that the tariff be suspended for 60 days beyond the proposed effective date.
