On July 14, 2016, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing for approval of a Microduct Language and Rate Update Amendment to an interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC and CenturyLink Communications, LLC for the State of South Dakota. The filing was made pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252.

On July 21, 2016, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing of the amendment to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the parties' request for approval had August 2, 2016, to do so. No comments were filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31 and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.

At its August 16, 2016, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the negotiated amendment to the agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC and CenturyLink Communications, LLC. Commission Staff recommended approval.

In accordance with 47 U.S.C § 252(e)(2), the Commission found that the amendment to the agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the amendment and the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the amendment to the agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC and CenturyLink Communications, LLC.
