On September 30, 2016, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing pursuant to 47 USC § 252 for approval of a Lifeline/Link Up and Tribal Lifeline Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC and Enventis Telecom, Inc. dba Consolidated Communications.

On October 6, 2016, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing of the agreement to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listsery. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the parties' request for approval had until October 20, 2016, to do so. No comments were filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31 and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.

At its October 26, 2016, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the negotiated amendment to the agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC and Enventis Telecom, Inc. dba Consolidated Communications. Commission Staff recommended approval.

In accordance with 47 U.S.C § 252(e)(2), the Commission found that the amendment to the agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the amendment and the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the amendment to the agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC and Enventis Telecom, Inc. dba Consolidated Communications.
