On December 7, 2013, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a petition by YMax Communications Corp. (YMax) requesting approval to designate YMax as an eligible telecommunications carrier throughout the Qwest Corporation d/b/a Century Link service area pursuant to 47 U.S.C. Section 214(e) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and the Commission's rules and regulations, for the purpose of receiving federal Lifeline universal service support.

On December 13, 2012, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of December 28, 2012, to interested individuals and entities. No petitions to intervene were filed. On May 3, 2013, YMax filed a letter requesting withdrawal without prejudice of its petition.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31 and ARSD 20:10:01:02.04.

At its regular meeting on May 21, 2013, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission voted unanimously to grant YMax's request to withdraw its petition without prejudice. It is therefore

ORDERED, that YMax's request to withdraw its petition without prejudice is hereby granted.
