**ORDER APPROVING
AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT**

TC12-194

On December 26, 2012, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252 for approval of an ICC VoIP Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC (CenturyLink) and Windstream KDL, Inc. (Windstream) for the State of South Dakota.

On December 27, 2012, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing of the amendment to interested individuals and entities. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the parties' request for approval had until January 15, 2013, to do so. No comments were filed.

At its January 30, 2013, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the negotiated amendment to the agreement between CenturyLink and Windstream. Commission Staff recommended approval.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31 and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. In accordance with 47 U.S.C § 252(e)(2), the Commission found that the amendment to the agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the amendment and the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the amendment to the agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the amendment to the interconnection agreement between CenturyLink and Windstream.
