Dear South Dakota Public Utilities Commissioners Hanson, Nelson, and Fiegen:

Please reject the Keystone XL Pipeline certification in docket HP14-001.

This pipeline and its construction pose unacceptable risks to the health, safety, and security of South Dakota's water, land, and people.

The final Environmental Impact Statement submitted by the State Department shows the pipeline is **expected** to leak at least ten times over the course of its lifetime. We are not willing to sacrifice and risk the Missouri River, the Ogallala Aquifer, our rural water systems, and our livelihoods for dirty tarsands oil.

Additionally, the construction of the pipeline puts rural communities at risk with the drastic influx of people, equipment, and traffic.

For these reasons and more, reject Keystone XL.
