

The accompanying electric tariff sheet issued by MidAmerican Energy Company is transmitted to you for filing.

Proposed effective date: September 1, 1999

With this filing, MidAmerican Energy Company proposes to add Price Code DM7 (energy and maintenance) for a 400-watt High Pressure Sodium (HPS) street light. The proposed price of \$7.36 was developed as the sum of two components. The first component was the current tariffed price for energy for a customer-owned and maintained light (Price Code DE7), or \$4.90. The second component is for maintenance. It is the difference between Price Code DM6 (energy and maintenance) of \$5.67, and Price Code DE6 (energy only) of \$3.21, or \$2.46. The sum of the \$4.90 for energy and \$2.46 for maintenance equals the proposed price of \$7.36 for Price Code DM7.

Notice of the proposed tariff change will be posted in each area office.

An original and ten copies of this Electric Advice Letter No. 8 and tariff sheet are submitted herewith.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A. Further, the revisions are just and reasonable and shall be approved. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED, that MidAmerican's revised tariff as described above is approved and shall be effective for service rendered on and after September 1, 1999.
