Dear Secretary Bose:

In accordance with Section 205 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824d and Sections 35.1 and 131.52 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission’s (“FERC”) regulations, MidAmerican Energy Company (“MidAmerican”) hereby submits a Certificate of Concurrence to the filing made by the Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc. (“MISO”) and Ameren Services Company (“Ameren Services”), on behalf of Ameren Illinois Company d/b/a Ameren Illinois (“Ameren Illinois”) in Docket No. ER16-463-000. The filing in Docket No. ER16-463-000 consisted of an executed Amended and Restated Transmission Interconnection Agreement (“Interconnection Agreement”) between MISO, Ameren Illinois and MidAmerican.<sup>1</sup>

The Interconnection Agreement supersedes an earlier version of the agreement that was executed by the same parties and designated by FERC as Original Service Agreement No. 2765. FERC accepted the filing of Original Service Agreement No. 2765 on June 4, 2015.<sup>2</sup>

### **I. Description of Filing**

This filing consists of Certificate of Concurrence (Attachment 1) and Tariff Record (Attachment 2) adopting the following rate schedule:
