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

Pursuant to SDCL 49-41B-15 and 49-41B-16, the South Dakota (Commission) will hold a public input hearing at the above time and place. TransCanada Keystone Pipeline LP (TransCanada) seeking approval for a pipeline. On April 27, 2007, TransCanada Keystone Pipeline LP filed an application for the South Dakota portion of the Keystone Pipeline Project. The proposed pipeline will have a nominal capacity of 435,000 barrels per day with a possible expansion to 591,000 bpd. The proposed route will enter South Dakota at the South Dakota/Nebraska border in Yankton County. The length of the pipeline in South Dakota will be approximately 220 miles and it will cross the counties of Kingsbury, Miner, Hanson, McCook, Hutchinson and Yankton. The proposed pipeline will have mainline valves with an average spacing of 15 miles between valves.

At the hearing, interested persons may appear and present comments regarding the application. Pursuant to SDCL 49-41B-15(5) the following County Auditor Offices: Marshall County, Day County, Kingsbury County, Miner County, Hanson County, McCook County, and Hutchinson County. The application is also on file in the Commission's office in Pierre, South Dakota and the application and all other documents in the case may also be viewed on a web site at www.puc.sd.gov under "Commission Actions," "Oil and Gas," "Hydrocarbon Pipeline Dockets," "HF07-001."

The parties to this proceeding are currently TransCanada and the Commission. Pursuant to SDCL 49-41B-17, any person residing in the area of the project, any governmental agency in the project area, any non-profit organization, any person or organization that promotes conservation or natural beauty, to protect the environment, to preserve biological values, to preserve historical sites, to promote conservation, or to promote the orderly development of the area, or any other interested person, may be granted formal party status in this proceeding. An interested person may apply for party status by filing an application with the Commission as provided in ARSD 20:10-22-40. Application forms for party status will be available at all public input hearings.
