### **The Exchanges**

#### **The Splitrock Exchanges**

1. The Oldham/Ramon Exchange, located entirely within the State of South Dakota, serves approximately 366 access lines.
2. The Howard/Carthage Exchange, located entirely within the State of South Dakota, serves approximately 964 access lines.

The number of access lines served within the Splitrock Exchanges is approximately 1,330, of which all are located entirely within the State of South Dakota.

#### **The Hills Exchanges**

1. The North Larchwood Exchange, located entirely within the State of South Dakota, serves approximately 1 access line.
2. The Valley Springs Exchange, located entirely within the State of South Dakota, serves approximately 422 access lines.
3. The Alvord Exchange, located entirely within the State of Iowa, serves approximately 210 access lines.
4. The Larchwood Exchange, located entirely within the State of Iowa, serves approximately 702 access lines.
5. The Lester Exchange, located entirely within the State of Iowa, serves approximately 271 access lines.
6. The Inwood Exchange, located entirely within the State of Iowa, serves approximately 752 access lines.
7. The South Valley Springs Exchange, located entirely within the State of Iowa, serves approximately 13 access lines.
8. The South Steen Exchange, located entirely within the State of Iowa, serves approximately 8 access lines.
9. The South Hills Exchange, located entirely within the State of Iowa, serves approximately 2 access lines.

10. The North Lester Exchange, located entirely within the State of Minnesota, serves approximately 1 access line.
11. The East Valley Springs Exchange, located entirely within the State of Minnesota, serves approximately 41 access lines.
12. The Steen Exchange, located entirely within the State of Minnesota, serves approximately 116 access lines.
13. The Hills Exchange, located entirely within the State of Minnesota, serves approximately 468 access lines.

The number of access lines served within the Hills Exchanges is approximately 3,007, of which 423 are located entirely within the State of South Dakota.
