

**South Dakota Public Utilities Commission Docket TC12-098 Data Request**

1-1 Section 14.3 describes a retroactive application of the PVU-C if customers supply by July 13, 2012. This only leaves customers one week after the possible approval of the tariff. Would Sprint agree to an August 31, 2012 deadline?

**RESPONSE:** Yes.

1-2 Section 14.6 describes Sprint's PVU-C auditing procedures. Are these auditing procedures linked to the PVU Factor Verification described in 14.5, or do they impose a separate mode of customer verification? And, do the items listed in 14.6 place limitation on the customers or merely provide items which might spur an audit? For example, are customers limited to a 5% increase in PVU-C factor from one quarter to the next?

**RESPONSE:** No, the Auditing procedures are not necessarily linked to the Verification process; although they could. No, the items listed in 14.6 do not place limitations on customers but are examples of when an audit might be spurred.
