Dear Ms. Van Gerpen:

The FCC ruled that all VOIP traffic (both originating and terminating) will be billed at interstate access rates. On April 25, 2012, the FCC released a Second Order of Reconsideration, which becomes effective on July 13, 2012. Beginning on July 13, 2012, the FCC is delaying the interstate rate treatment of **originating** intrastate interexchange VOIP-PSTN traffic Minutes of Use (MOU) until July 1, 2014. The treatment of **terminating** VOIP will continue to be billed at interstate rates as stated in the initial order.

This filing makes the following changes to AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc.’s Access Services and Network Interconnection Services Tariff.
