Please specify the pages from where the rate elements were gathered in the FCC Tariff and the rate elements used from the FCC Tariff to calculate the rate for the “Switched exchange access, per terminating minute” rate in the South Dakota P.U.C. Tariff No. 2. Also please show the calculation used to come up with the composite intrastate rate.

Response:

For purposes of this response, “FCC Tariff” is presumed to mean the interstate switched exchange access tariff of the dominant incumbent local exchange carrier on which dishNET’s composite switched exchange access rates are based. Pursuant to Section 61.26 of the Federal Communications Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. §61.26, the Company’s interstate rates are set at parity with [Qwest Corporation Tariff FCC No. 1, Section 6](#).

dishNET’s composite South Dakota switched access rate effective on July 1, 2013 is set at parity with the Company’s interstate rate pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §51.911(c), and is comprised of the following incumbent carrier rate elements, with citation to the page number in Qwest Corporation Tariff FCC No. 1, Section 6, where the element appears. Rates are on a per minute basis:
