**Adjusted Gross Income Compliance**

FSA has a form called the GGC-931 (Average Adjusted Gross Income Certification and Consent to Disclosure of Tax Information). This form is required of all producers who receive program benefits. This form must be timely filed as a condition to do either of the following:

- Receive 2012 program benefits
- Maintain payment eligibility for previous years 2009 through 2011.

By completing this form, producers are certifying that they are within the income guidelines that are required for FSA and NRC's programs. Also by completing this form producers are consenting for FSA to determine if they have completed the forms correctly. This form needs to be completed each year. Those who have not done it before this year are in jeopardy of repaying all payments for the years 2009-2011. Please check with our office if you are in doubt as to whether you have done this or not.
