This item was just missed. The percent for Safety Net Additive Support (SNA) for South Dakota is \$415.
- 1.2. Is the (\$968) of Interstate Access Support (IAS) supposed to be reported as Local Switching Support (LSS), if not please explain. (See Attachment of USAC report and Staff Calculations).
Yes the (\$968) should be reported as Local Switching Support (LSS) and not Interstate Access Support (IAS).
- 1.3. Explain some of the capital additions made in 2013 and what area(s) the \$965 in reported cable and wire additions serviced.
The \$965 is an allocation based on percentage of access lines. Areas served are portions of Deuel and Grant County's.
- 1.4. Please confirm that pursuant to ARSD 20:10:30:55, customers receive written notification of Lifeline availability within 30 days of receiving service.
