On December 4, 2001, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Chari Sazue, Aberdeen, South Dakota (Complainant), against ILD Teleservices, Inc. (ILD) and WebNet Communications, Inc. (WebNet) regarding unauthorized switching of services.

On December 4, 2001, the complaint was faxed to ILD and WebNet. Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:09, ILD and WebNet were notified that they must satisfy the complaint or file answers in writing with the Commission by December 24, 2001. On December 19, 2001, the Commission received an e-mail response from ILD. On December 28, 2001, the Commission received an answer from WebNet.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-7.2, 49-31-7.3, 49-31-7.4, 49-31-10, 49-31-11, 49-31-38, 49-31-38.1, 49-31-38.2, 49-31-38.3, 49-31-89 through 49-31-97, inclusive, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:34.

By order dated January 7, 2002, a hearing was scheduled for January 24, 2002, beginning at 8:30 A.M., in the Cactus Conference Room, Public Utilities Commission, State Capitol Building, 500 E. Capitol, Pierre, South Dakota. Commission Staff has now been informed that settlement had been reached in this matter, so therefore the hearing is cancelled. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the hearing scheduled for January 24, 2002, is cancelled.
