On September 3, 2003, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Jim Holmes, Sioux Falls, South Dakota (Complainant), against MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) regarding disconnection.

On September 4, 2003, the complaint was faxed to MidAmerican. Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:09, MidAmerican was notified that it must satisfy the complaint or file an answer in writing with the Commission by September 24, 2003. The Commission has not received an answer from MidAmerican to this complaint. On September 22, 2003, the Commission received a satisfaction and resolution of complaint from MidAmerican.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-34A.

On October 16, 2003, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Upon recommendation of Commission Staff, the Commission voted to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the complaint shall be dismissed and the docket closed.
