On December 12, 2007, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) requesting approval to remove tariff language regarding charging customers for the installation of excess flow valves. For new or replacement single residence, residential service lines operating at ten pounds per square inch gauge or greater, MidAmerican will install EFVs as a standard construction practice and customers will not be subject to installation or post-installation costs as a result of this change in construction practice. The revised tariff sheet is as follows:

2nd Revised Sheet No. 12

Canceling 1st Revised Sheet No. 12

At its regularly scheduled meeting of January 15, 2008, the Commission discussed final approval of the application. Commission Staff recommended approval of the revisions to the tariff sheet.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A, specifically, 49-34A-2, 49-34A-4, 49-34A-6, 49-34A-8, and 49-34A-10 and ARSD 20:10:17:03. The Commission finds the revisions are just and reasonable and approves the revisions. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the above-referenced revised tariff is approved and is effective as of January 31, 2008.
