On March 2, 2009, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (MDU) filed for approval with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) to remove the experimental qualifier associated with its Gas Conservation Program. The Company is proposing to continue the application of Rate 90 and expand its natural gas portfolio to include four additional gas conservation programs and remove the experimental nature of the current tariff through the implementation of a biennial review of the Company's portfolio of programs to be filed by June 1 of every other year. On April 1, 2009, MDU amended its filing to update the conservation tracking adjustment surcharge and to request that if Commission Staff requires more time to evaluate MDU's new plan, that the existing plan be extended. Commission Staff recommend the existing program be extended until September 30, 2009, to allow time for further review of MDU's proposed changes. The revised tariff sheets were as follows:

Section No. 1:

4th Revised Sheet No. 1, canceling 3rd Revised Sheet No. 1

Section No. 3:

53rd Revised Sheet No. 1, canceling 52nd Revised Sheet No. 1
3rd Revised Sheet No. 31, canceling 2nd Revised Sheet No. 31

At its regularly scheduled meeting of April 21, 2009, the Commission approved MDU's revised tariffs as described above effective as of May 1, 2009, and continued MDU's existing Gas Conservation Program until September 30, 2009.

On September 16, 2009, MDU filed for approval with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) for an extension of its current Gas Conservation Program through October 31, 2009. MDU requested approval on less than 30 days notice. The revised tariff sheet is as follows:

Section No. 3:

4th Revised Sheet No. 31, canceling 3rd Revised Sheet No. 31

At its regularly scheduled meeting of September 22, 2009, the Commission considered approval of the amended application. Commission Staff recommended the existing plan be continued until October 31, 2009.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A. Further, MDU's existing Gas Conservation Program shall be continued until October 31, 2009, on less than 30 days notice. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED, that MDU's revised tariff as described above is approved effective as of October 1, 2009, and MDU's existing Gas Conservation Program shall be continued until October 31, 2009, on less than 30 days notice.
